## GPS Treasure Hunt

GPS is simple to grasp and great fun to use. We equip each of your teams with a GPS handset. The GPS will pinpoint your current position with great accuracy and then guide you on a route to a series of landmarks programmed into the GPS unit.

Following a GPS route is quite straightforward in open areas, such as parkland where you can follow a straight-line bearing. In the urban jungle (or perhaps a scenic town or village) it's not quite so easy! For example, the GPS may be guiding you straight ahead but the junction you have reached only offers a left or right choice of routes. Decision time! Wherever you move, your current position is updated every few seconds with information about where you are in relation to your target.

**The great thing about the *GPS Treasure Hunt* is the flexibility.** The treasure quest can be highly cryptic or a collaborative effort to reach the prize. Or we can take your participants on a treasure trail that visits fine sites or historic landmarks.

The treasure hunt ends with the treasure chest being opened - often just seconds before the final deadline!

**TEAM LEARNING:** plan and prioritize, gain an awareness of all the team's strengths, get to know each other and form a strategy as a group.
